## **Vaccination and Screening Requirements**

## Definitions:

- Routine Screening: Includes temperature, symptoms, exposure, hand hygiene and surgical mask. Required for all individuals entering the community.
- Visitor Screening: Proof of vaccination or negative COVID test within 72 hours of indoor visit.
- <u>Staff requirements for vaccination</u>: Fully vaccinated, or approved exemption with weekly COVID testing.
